Easy access to the MCG in the heart of Melbourne

Jolimont and Richmond train stations are within a five minute walk of Gate 3 at the MCG.

Tram numbers 48 and 75 run along Wellington Parade from the city. Disembark at the Pullman Hotel.

Tram number **70** runs through the Melbourne Park precinct. Disembark at Rod Laver Arena and walk over the footbridge. All tram stops are within a five minute walk of Gate 3 at the MCG.

Operating every 30 minutes between 9.30am and 4pm, the Melbourne Visitor Shuttle travels through Melbourne's inner city points of interest. Stopping at the MCG on all non-match days. Visit thatsmelbourne.com.au for more details.
